


• 58% of graduates enrolled in a postsecondary institution within 12 months versus 49% in peer counties. 2021



- \$43,544 annual average earnings of graduates employed in NC (includes both part-time and full-time jobs)




**15.0%** of young adults ages 16-24 in Davie County were **not working and not in school** versus **15.2%** in peer counties. 2019

# **Promising Attainment Practices**


