

Access to Postsecondary Credits

Students in Edgecombe County completed **491 Career & Technical Education (CTE)** credentials (**184 (37%) were industry-valued credentials) and 355 concentrations** in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations completed include Hospitality & Tourism; Human Services; and Arts, Audio/Video Technology, & Communications.

153 high school students took at least one AP test (9%) versus 8% in peer counties (2023).




167 high school students participated in Career & College Promise programs (44%) versus 43% in peer counties (2023).


