




First-time Curriculum Enrollments

How students in McDowell County traditional schools are doing:

• McDowell County has met the goal for Pre-K enrollment. (Goal: 75%). 2023

 27% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4) or 5) in reading, compared to 30% statewide; 1,495 more needed to meet state goal of 73%. 2023

 30% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in math, compared to 35% statewide; 1,413 more needed to meet state goal of 86%. 2023

• 84% of 9th graders graduate within four years, compared to 87% statewide; 50 more needed to meet state goal of 95%. 2023

· 30% of students are chronically absent from school, compared to 27% statewide; 1,073 less needed to meet state goal of 11%. 2023

Access to Postsecondary Credits

Students in McDowell County completed 2,376 Career & Technical Education (CTE) credentials (319 (13%) were industry-valued credentials) and 251 concentrations in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations completed include Law, Public Safety, Corrections, & Security; Manufacturing; and Arts, Audio/Video Technology, & Communications.



132 high school students took at least one **AP test** (7%) versus 8% in peer counties (2023).




