



• 67% of graduates reported intentions to enroll in a postsecondary institution versus 73% in peer counties. 2022

 51% of graduates enrolled in a postsecondary institution within 12 months versus 57% in peer counties. 2022

POSTSECONDARY COMPLETION

57% of Onslow County students have parents with no college degree (either 2- or 4-year) versus 48% in peer counties.

How students in Onslow County traditional schools are doing:

· 32% of eligible 4-year-olds enrolled in NC Pre-K program, compared to 53% statewide; 837 more needed to meet state goal of 75%. 2023

 28% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4) or 5) in reading, compared to 30% statewide; 7,526 more needed to meet state goal of 73%. 2023

 28% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in math, compared to 35% statewide; 7,474 more needed to meet state goal of 86%. 2023

• 91% of 9th graders graduate within four years, compared to 87% statewide; 76 more needed to meet state goal of 95%. 2023

• 26% of students are chronically absent from school, compared to 27% statewide; 4,435 less needed to meet state goal of 11%. 2023




Onslow County has a student-to-school counselor ratio of 485:1 versus 327:1 in peer counties. 2023

Access to Postsecondary Credits

Students in Onslow County completed 5,925 Career & Technical Education (CTE) credentials (1,499 (25%) were industry-valued credentials) and 1,447 concentrations in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations completed include Human Services: Health Science: and Architecture and Construction.




