



POSTSECONDARY COMPLETION

57% of Richmond County students have parents with no college degree (either 2- or 4-year) versus 55% in peer counties.

How students in Richmond County traditional schools are doing:

· 67% of eligible 4-year-olds enrolled in NC Pre-K program, compared to 53% statewide; 26 more needed to meet state goal of 75%. 2023

 19% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in reading, compared to 30% statewide; 1,932 more needed to meet state goal of 73%. 2023

 26% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in math, compared to 35% statewide; 1,750 more needed to meet state goal of 86%. 2023

• 80% of 9th graders graduate within four years, compared to 87% statewide; 79 more needed to meet state goal of 95%. 2023

· 29% of students are chronically absent from school, compared to 27% statewide; 1,229 less needed to meet state goal of 11%. 2023




CADEMIC READINESS

Access to Postsecondary Credits

Students in Richmond County completed 2,249 Career & Technical Education (CTE) credentials (197 (9%) were industry-valued credentials) and 261 concentrations in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations completed include Manufacturing; Health Science; and Information Technology.


