



Alamance, Caswell, Davidson, Davie, Forsyth, Guilford, Randolph, Rockingham, Stokes, Surry, and Yadkin Counties


Charter schools are public schools that must be authorized by the NC State Board of Education to operate. Like traditional public schools, charter schools are primarily funded through state and local tax dollars and are prohibited from discriminating in admissions, having religious affiliations, or charging tuition. Charter schools are held accountable through the State assessment and accountability system.¹ Because charter schools have open enrollment and often serve students from multiple counties, charter school profiles are aggregated up to the Prosperity-Zone level. In Piedmont Triad there are 27 charter schools and 16 traditional public school districts operating 429 schools.

82.7% of students who enroll **persist to their second year**.
State: 86.3%, 2023

53.4% of students who enroll **earn a degree or certificate** within 6 years. State: 70.5%, 2023


COLLEGE & CAREER ACCESS

How students in Piedmont Triad Charter Schools are planning for and enrolling in college:

59.1% of 2024 high school class **completed the FAFSA** as of Sept. 27, 2024. 164 more need to complete in 2024 to meet state goal of **80%**. State: 58.8%

68.4% of graduates **enrolled in a postsecondary institution** within 12 months. State: 72.5% 2023

ACADEMIC READINESS

Piedmont Triad Charter School students:

34.2% of 3-8 graders **earned college-and-career-ready scores in reading** in 2024. 4,211 more needed to meet state goal of **73%**. State: 36.6%

36.3% of 3-8 graders **earned college-and-career-ready scores in math** in 2024. 5,397 more needed to meet state goal of **86%**. State: 38.5%

17.4% of students were **chronically absent from school** in 2024. 1,397 fewer needed to meet state goal of **11.0%**. State: 19.3%

0.4% of students **drop out of high school** (2 total students), compared to **1.0%** statewide. 2023

Pathways to College and Career

Students in charter schools completed **<10 Career & Technical Education (CTE) credentials and <10 concentrations**. **<10 (<5%) of credentials were industry-valued** in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations: Information Technology; Business Management & Administration; and Education & Training.

634 (17.7%) high school students took at least one **AP, IB, or CIE exam**. State: 21.3% (2023).

303 (41.3%) high school graduates participated in **Career & College Promise programs**. State: 42.7% (2024).
