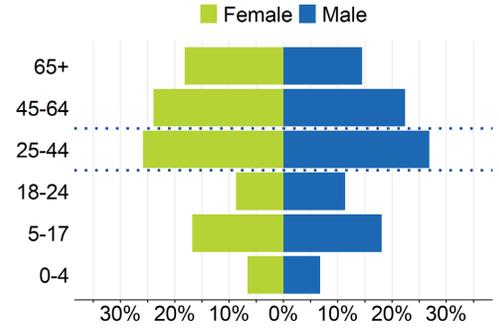

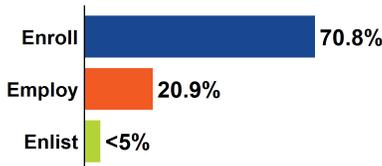

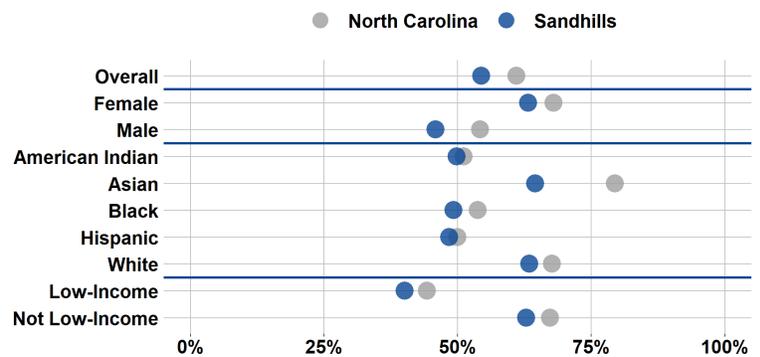
Post High School Graduation Intentions, 2023

ACADEMIC READINESS

61.5% of eligible 4-year-olds **enrolled in NC Pre-K program** in 2024. 854 more needed to meet state goal of **75%**. State: 57.2%

Sandhills Traditional Public Schools students:

23.9% of 3-8 graders **earned college-and-career-ready scores in reading** in 2024. 35,415 more needed to meet state goal of **86%**. State: 29.8%

26.9% of 3-8 graders **earned college-and-career-ready scores in math** in 2024. 26,305 more needed to meet state goal of **73%**. State: 36.5%

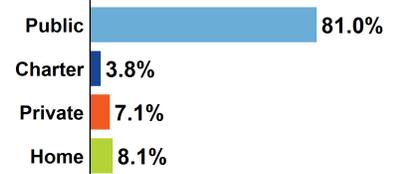
31.5% of students were **chronically absent from school** in 2024. 27,677 fewer needed to meet state goal of **11%**. State: 25.7%

Pathways to College and Career

Students in traditional public schools completed **42,382 Career & Technical Education (CTE) credentials and 7,062 concentrations.** **5,832 (13.8%) of credentials were industry-valued** in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations: Agricultural, Food, & Natural Resources; Health Science; and Human Services.

3,462 (9.0%) high school students took at least one **AP, IB, or CIE exam.** State: 16.8% (2023).

3,993 (43.1%) high school graduates participated in **Career & College Promise programs.** State: 36.0% (2024).
