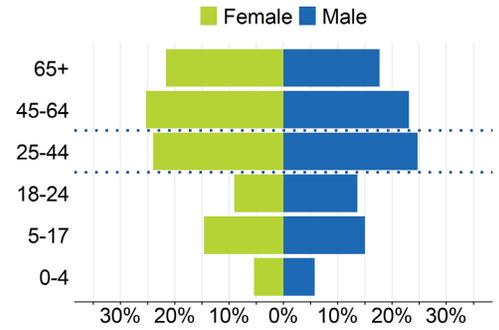

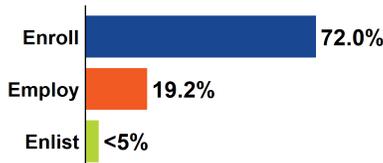

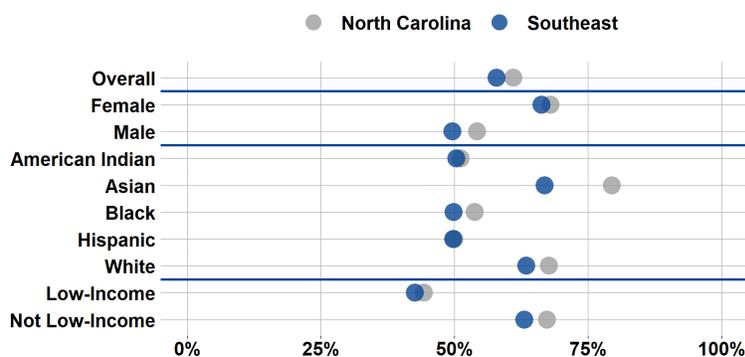
### Post High School Graduation Intentions, 2023

ACADEMIC READINESS

65.2% of eligible 4-year-olds enrolled in NC Pre-K program in 2024. 534 more needed to meet state goal of 75%. State: 57.2%

### Southeast Traditional Public Schools students:

28.4% of 3-8 graders earned college-and-career-ready scores in reading in 2024. 35,543 more needed to meet state goal of 86%. State: 29.8%

35.1% of 3-8 graders earned college-and-career-ready scores in math in 2024. 23,356 more needed to meet state goal of 73%. State: 36.5%

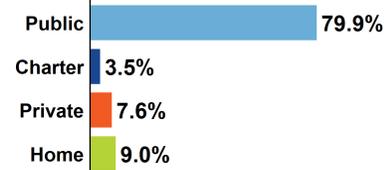
26.8% of students were chronically absent from school in 2024. 22,610 fewer needed to meet state goal of 11%. State: 25.7%

### Pathways to College and Career

Students in traditional public schools completed 34,717 Career & Technical Education (CTE) credentials and 6,779 concentrations. 6,306 (18.2%) of credentials were industry-valued in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations: Human Services; Health Science; and Agricultural, Food, & Natural Resources.

4,306 (10.4%) high school students took at least one AP, IB, or CIE exam. State: 16.8% (2023).

4,178 (41.7%) high school graduates participated in Career & College Promise programs. State: 36.0% (2024).
