



How students in Onslow County traditional schools are doing:

- 32% of eligible 4-year-olds enrolled in NC Pre-K program, compared to 53% statewide; 837 more needed to meet state goal of 75%. 2023
- 28% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in **reading**, compared to **30%** statewide; 7,526 more needed to meet state goal of **73%.** 2023
- 28% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in **math**, compared to **35%** statewide; 7,474 more needed to meet state goal of **86%**. 2023
- 91% of 9th graders graduate within four years, compared to 87% statewide; 76 more needed to meet state goal of 95%. 2023
- 32% of students are chronically absent from school, compared to 32% statewide; 6,149 less needed to meet state goal of 11%. 2022



Access to Postsecondary Credits

Students in Onslow County completed **3,782 Career & Technical Education (CTE)** credentials (industry-valued credential data available in Spring **2024**) and **1,264** concentrations in 2022. The top three CTE concentrations completed include Human Services; Health Science; and Agricultural, Food, & Natural Resources.



908 high school students took at least one AP course (12%) versus 14% in peer counties (2022).



667 high school students participated in **Career & College Promise programs (20%)** versus **23%** in peer counties (2022).
