Top Opportunities for Growth

These three areas represent the biggest opportunities for Onslow County to improve future attainment outcomes.



NC Pre-K Enrollment

32% of Onslow County eligible 4-year-olds are enrolled in NC Pre-K, below the suburban county average of 45%.



Earning College Credit in High School

27% of Onslow County graduates participated in Career & College Promise programs, below the suburban county average of 39%. Also, 11% of high school students took at least one AP exam, below the peer county average of 15%.



School Counselors

Onslow County has a student-to-school counselor ratio of 485:1, above the suburban county average of 327:1.

Promising Attainment Practices

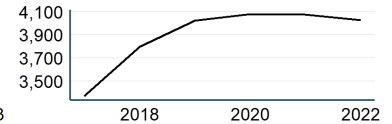

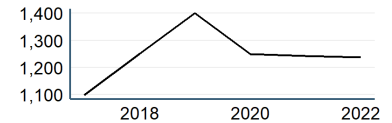

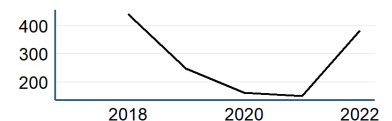

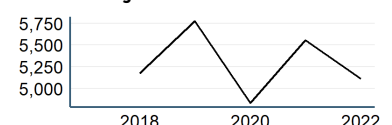
First-time Curriculum Enrollments

15% of Onslow County residents have **student loan debt**; 10% of debt holders had **student loans in default**. 2022

Success of Onslow County High School Graduates

- 77% of students who enroll **persist to their second year** versus 82% in peer counties. 2022
- 56% of students who enroll **earn a degree or certificate** within 6 years versus 60% in peer counties. 2022

Top destinations of all college-goers, Fall 2023

- 5,016 of all college-goers attended **Coastal Carolina CC**
- 535 of all college-goers attended **Cape Fear CC**
- 281 of all college-goers attended **Carteret CC**

• 54% of seniors **completed the FAFSA** in 2023, compared to 62% statewide; 436 more need to complete in 2023 to meet state goal of 80%. 2023

• 67% of graduates reported **intentions to enroll** in a postsecondary institution versus 73% in peer counties. 2022

• 51% of graduates **enrolled in a postsecondary institution** within 12 months versus 57% in peer counties. 2022



57% of Onslow County students have **parents with no college degree** (either 2- or 4-year) versus 48% in peer counties.

How students in Onslow County traditional schools are doing:

• 32% of eligible 4-year-olds **enrolled in NC Pre-K program**, compared to 53% statewide; 837 more needed to meet state goal of 75%. 2023

• 28% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in **reading**, compared to 30% statewide; 7,526 more needed to meet state goal of 73%. 2023

• 28% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in **math**, compared to 35% statewide; 7,474 more needed to meet state goal of 86%. 2023

• 91% of 9th graders **graduate within four years**, compared to 87% statewide; 76 more needed to meet state goal of 95%. 2023

• 26% of students are **chronically absent from school**, compared to 27% statewide; 4,435 less needed to meet state goal of 11%. 2023

2% of students **drop out of high school** (126 total students), compared to 2% statewide. 2023

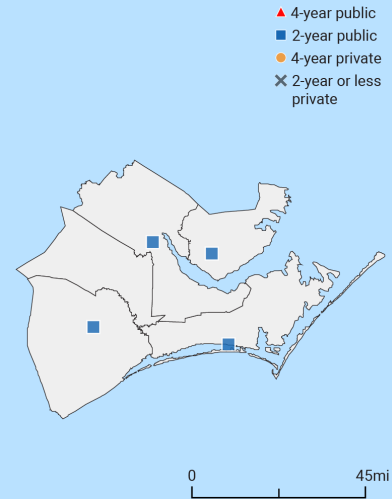

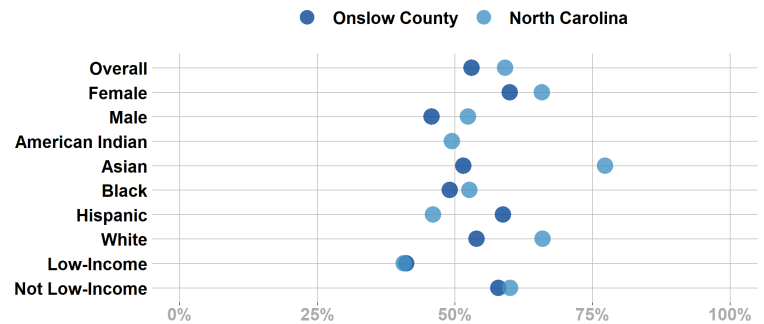

Postsecondary Enrollment Rates for Select Groups in Onslow County, 2022

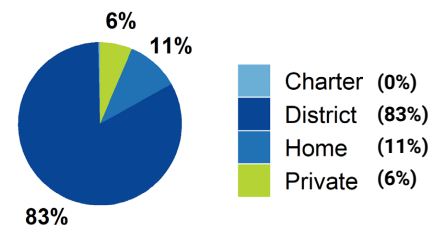

Access to Postsecondary Credits

Students in Onslow County completed 5,925 Career & Technical Education (CTE) credentials (1,499 (25%) were industry-valued credentials) and 1,447 concentrations in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations completed include Human Services; Health Science; and Architecture and Construction.



879 high school students took at least one **AP test** (11%) versus 15% in peer counties (2023).



492 high school students participated in **Career & College Promise programs** (27%) versus 39% in peer counties (2023).
