



#### 56% of seniors completed the FAFSA in 2023, compared to 62% statewide; 2,139 more need to complete in 2023 to meet state goal of 80%. 2023

- 81% of graduates reported **intentions to enroll** in a postsecondary institution versus **74%** in the state. 2022
- **54%** of graduates **enrolled in a postsecondary institution** within 12 months versus **58%** in the state. 2022

#### How students in Southeast traditional schools are currently doing:

To meet state goals, each year Southeast needs:

- 54% of eligible 4-year-olds enrolled in NC Pre-K program, compared to 53% statewide; 1,281 more needed to meet state goal of 75%. 2023
- ullet 29% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in **reading**, compared to **30%** statewide; 27,646 more needed to meet state goal of **73%.** 2023
- 33% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in **math**, compared to **35%** statewide; 33,197 more needed to meet state goal of **86%**. 2023
- 86% of 9th graders graduate within four years, compared to 87% statewide; 1,002 more needed to meet state goal of 95%. 2023
- 33% of students are chronically absent from school, compared to 32% statewide; 31,097 less needed to meet state goal of 11%. 2022



# School Choice

## **Access to Postsecondary Credits**

Students in Southeast completed **26,173 Career & Technical Education (CTE) credentials (industry-valued credential data available in Spring 2024) and 5,495 concentrations** in 2022. The top three CTE concentrations completed include Human Services; Health Science; and Agricultural, Food, & Natural Resources.



**4,075 high school students** took at least one **AP course (10%)** versus **15%** in the state (2022).



**5,462 high school students** participated in **Career & College Promise programs (30%)** versus **23%** in the state (2022).
