



- 70% of seniors completed the FAFSA in 2023, compared to 62% statewide; 512 more need to complete in 2023 to meet state goal of 80%.
- 90% of graduates reported **intentions to enroll** in a postsecondary institution versus **74%** in the state. 2022
- 60% of graduates enrolled in a postsecondary institution within 12 months versus 58% in the state. 2022

#### How students in GuilfordWorks traditional schools are currently doing:

To meet state goals, each year GuilfordWorks needs:

- 71% of eligible 4-year-olds enrolled in NC Pre-K program, compared to 53% statewide; 107 more needed to meet state goal of 75%. 2023
- 27% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in **reading**, compared to **30%** statewide; 13,909 more needed to meet state goal of **73%**. 2023
- 29% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in **math**, compared to **35%** statewide; 17,075 more needed to meet state goal of **86%**. 2023
- 91% of 9th graders graduate within four years, compared to 87% statewide; 237 more needed to meet state goal of 95%. 2023
- 31% of students are chronically absent from school, compared to 27% statewide; 14,277 less needed to meet state goal of 11%. 2023



#### **School Choice**

88,117 total students were enrolled in K-12 in GuilfordWorks in the 2022-23 school year.

## **Access to Postsecondary Credits**

Students in GuilfordWorks completed **8,250 Career & Technical Education (CTE)** credentials (**1,451 (18%)** were industry-valued credentials) and **2,741** concentrations in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations completed include Health

Science; Arts, Audio/Video Technology, & Communications; and Science, Technology, Engineering, & Mathematics.



**5,650 high school students** took at least one **AP test (27%)** versus **16%** in the state (2023).



**1,315 high school students** participated in **Career & College Promise programs (24%)** versus **36%** in the state (2023).
