





• 58% of eligible 4-year-olds **enrolled in NC Pre-K program**, compared to 53% statewide; 281 more needed to meet state goal of 75%. 2023

- 25% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in reading, compared to 30% statewide; 7,840 more needed to meet state goal of 73%. $_{\rm 2023}$

• 31% of 3-8 graders are earning college-and-career-ready scores (level 4 or 5) in math, compared to 35% statewide; 8,998 more needed to meet state goal of 86%. 2023

• 82% of 9th graders graduate within four years, compared to 87% statewide; 380 more needed to meet state goal of 95%. 2023

• 27% of students are chronically absent from school, compared to 27% statewide; 6,214 less needed to meet state goal of 11%. 2023

Access to Postsecondary Credits

Students in Rivers East completed **10,507 Career & Technical Education (CTE)** credentials (**1,883 (18%) were industry-valued credentials) and 1,903** concentrations in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations completed include Health Science; Human Services; and Manufacturing.


